

## NEW SCORING SYSTEM FOR THE COMPETITION LEAGUES 2020 – 2021

Competitors may submit up to 4 results per calendar month for Dressage and 4 results per calendar month for Performance and must provide evidence of their results.

For Show Jumping (SJ), Combined Training (CT) and Arena Eventing (AE) – 6 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place scaling down to 1.5 points for 10<sup>th</sup> place. Those completing and finishing 11<sup>th</sup> and below will be awarded 1 point. Elimination – No points. For the above classes, please insert the correct height in the relevant box. Do not enter your dressage score for Combined Training results – either place a tick in the relevant box or your overall placing. For Dressage (D) – please write your percentage in the relevant box: I = Intro, P = Prelim, N = Novice and E = Elementary, O = Other (Medium or above and DTM classes, please indicate which) Points are awarded on your percentage as follows – marks up to and including 60.00% score 1 point rising to a maximum score of 7.5 points for 74.00% and above.

### Results and qualification notes.

- Final scores for the National Unaffiliated League, the Newcomers' Unaffiliated League and the Riding Club Members' League to be announced as soon as possible after 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020
- In the event of equal scores: Dressage - the highest average percentage from the horse/rider combinations' top six results will be the higher place, Performance - the horse/rider combination with the highest number of wins (then if nec, the highest number of placings) will take the higher placing.
- RoR Regional recognition rosette for the highest placed point scorer overall in each Region in Dressage and Performance. In the 2020 - 2021 League, the top 75 in Dressage and the top 50 in Performance (SJ, CT and AE) will qualify for RoR National Championships in 2021.
- Rosettes to top ten in Dressage and to top ten overall in Performance (CT, SJ & AE) in the RoR National Unaffiliated League, the RoR Newcomers Unaffiliated League and the RoR Riding Club Members League.
- All competitors submitting score sheets are eligible to compete in Non Championship classes at the RoR National Championships.
- Previous winners of Regional League Championships at the RoR National Championships will no longer automatically qualify for the Finals.
- Details of the Finals, how to enter and the prize structure will be in the RoR National Championships Show Schedule, which will be released in 2021.
- The Finals may be held on grass or a surface and the Dressage will be judged by BD Listed Judges under BD rules and the Performance will be judged by a BS Judge on Style & Performance.
- Qualified dressage combinations may enter no more than two Championship classes at consecutive levels and must have submitted scores for those levels only throughout the League qualification period.
- Qualified performance combinations must enter either the 85cm or the 100m Championship classes and must have submitted scores up and to not above, the chosen level during the League qualification period.
- There will be open warm-up classes at each level at the finals.
- Combinations who have previously had a top three placing at Championship (RoR Regional Leagues or RoR Northern, Southern or Scottish Dressage Series) level in Intro, Prelim or Novice are no longer eligible to take part in the Championship class at those levels.
- Combinations who have previously won the Elementary Championship (RoR Regional Leagues or RoR Northern, Southern or Scottish Dressage Series) are no longer allowed to take part in the Championship class at that level.
- Combinations who have previously won a 80cm Championship class at Aintree are no longer eligible to take part in the Championship class at that level.
- **2019 – 2020 Regional League Championships.** All combinations that qualified for the cancelled Finals at Aintree automatically go through to the RoR National Unaffiliated Finals at the RoR National Championship Show 2021.
